- ☐ All operators must be over 21 years old and **have not consumed alcohol or drugs of any kind.**
- ☐ All operators and passengers must wear a life jacket at all times.
- ☐ Registration papers are in storage, water patrol and/or coast guard can pull you over and you will need to provide proper documentation for boat and operator (including MO Safety Certificate, if needed).
- ☐ Point out any damage prior to leaving Pointe Oasis. Most prior scratches and/or dents will be covered by a sticker. We will take video and do a visual inspection. Lessee is encouraged to take a video also.
- ☐ Key must be work on the operator's LEFT wrist at all times (demonstration provided). Do not let it wrap around the handlebars, if you happen to fall off, the cord will break and waverunner will continue to idle away from you at 6mph. You will not catch it.
- ☐ Waverunner operation: start button, throttle, reverse, never start out of the water (explain cavitations).
- ☐ Waverunners DO NOT have brakes, do not rely on reverse to slow you down or stop you, it takes 50 yards for a waverunner to come back to idle speed, plan ahead.
- ☐ No Wake and Danger buoys
- ☐ Stay at least 150 feet from shore, docks, boats, other waverunners and/or swimmers that aren't trading out to ride **and attempt to avoid all debris floating in the water.**
- ☐ When trading off riders or operators always idle, look for waves and make sure you are a safe distance from shore, docks, boats, and/or other waverunners. Never change riders and/or operators against a dock, damage WILL happen. **Do not pull a tube or other flotation device behind waverunner.**
- ☐ When taking small children for a ride, to avoid injury, do not go fast. Front riders can hit their face on the handlebars and behind riders can fall off.
- ☐ Never attempt to spray water, cross in front of or jump the wake of other waverunners or boats. Waverunners are legally required to yield to oncoming vessels or when watercraft are converging at an angle.
- ☐ ALWAYS look over BOTH shoulders before turning right or left. DO NOT use your mirrors for turning.
- ☐ If you capsize a waverunner, turn it upright by using the pull down bar at the back and turning it clockwise.
- ☐ Use the pull down bar at the back to get back onto the waverunner.
- ☐ Do not leave waverunner unattended on the lake and never tie up to a dock, damage will incur. Can use a power lift or drive on lift.
- ☐ Waverunners may need refueling every two hours, show gas gauge, how gauge works and location of gas cap
- ☐ Know where you are on the lake at all times, Pointe Oasis is at the 13mm of Wideford Cove. Landmarks include Cypress, Four Seasons, Palisades.
- ☐ Take your cell phone with you and place in dry storage. We have plastic baggies, if needed. Include the Pointe Oasis phone number in your contacts (573-374-1400).
- ☐ Show location of fire extinguisher. If fire occurs, do not attempt to fight it. Get off the waverunner and seek help immediately.
- ☐ Do NOT ride during inclement weather, especially lightening.
- ☐ If waverunner begins taking on water, get somewhere safe immediately and tie up the waverunner, if possible
- ☐ If waverunner goes into limp mode, you may have sucked debris into the impeller even if you didn't see anything in the water. Waverunner will not go over 10 mph and will have extreme vibrations, but you will be responsible for returning it to Pointe Oasis. Call for further instructions.
- ☐ When returning to Pointe Oasis, idle through the no wake zone and up to the rental lifts. Staff will inform you on when and how much to throttle in order to drive safely onto the lift.
- ☐ If damage occurs during rental, contact Pointe Oasis immediately this includes damaged caused by a third party. You may be required to contact water patrol and file a report.
- ☐ Pieces missing from the waverunner will be replaced at lesse's cost.
- ☐ All items damaged and/or not returned including life jackets will be assessed and charged

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING BOLD STATEMENTS AND SIGN THAT YOU UNDERSTAND AND AGREE WITH ALL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS THAT YOU HAVE BEEN PROVIDED WITH.

- **A \$500 deposit, per waverunner, will be taken on a valid credit card (no debit card) at the time of reservation. This will be refunded at the end of the rental if there has been no damage incurred.**
- **If damage is incurred, you will be charged. Costs include \$100 per inch of scratching or denting, \$500 if the fiberglass is punctured causing a hole, and if damage to waverunner is so severe that Pointe Oasis is unable to rent it out, you will be charged \$500 PER DAY until the waverunner is repaired and seaworthy.**
- **Exceeding your time limit without contacting Pointe Oasis will result in additional charges (\$100 per hour until returned).**
- **Water Patrol and/or Coast Guard can pull you over and you will need to provide proper documentation including a MO Boater’s Safety Certificate (for ages between 21 & 40)**
- **Injury and/or death on a waverunner can and does occur because operators are not paying attention and/or are breaking the law. Ensure you are knowledgeable on how to operate a waverunner and follow all safety rules and instructions provided during this class.**
