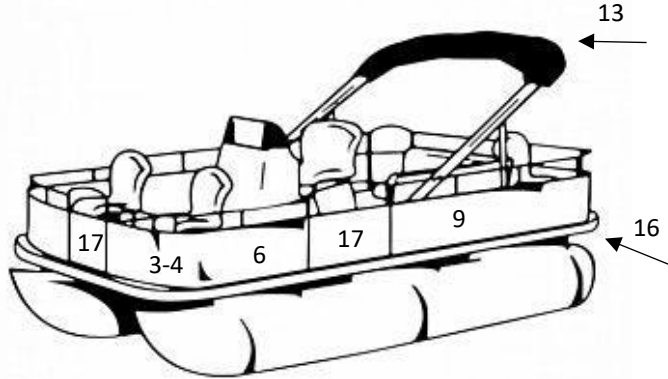
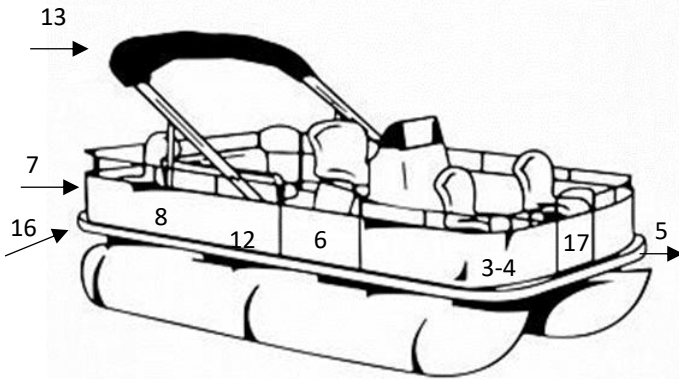

- ☐ Prop – visual check of nut, keeper, fins
- ☐ Cowl – visual check for cracks
- ☐ Tower – instruction on how to tie on tube/ski rope, **no other towing allowed**
- ☐ Ladder – instruction on use and information on raising and securing it for transport, never use with motor running
- ☐ Gas Tank – ensure cap is on if getting gas somewhere else
- ☐ Anchor Light – instruction on how to raise and lower and information on keeping it horizontal until needed and lowering when appropriate, **NO boating after dark**
- ☐ Bimini Top – visual check for condition, ensure all dock roofs are tall enough to accommodate height
- ☐ Bumpers – instruction on having them out when parking and in when moving and never untie and remove them from the boat
- ☐ Ropes – five total ropes will be counted upon return, four used for docking and one for lily pad
- ☐ Docking lines – two in the back and two in the front, tie up all four when parking especially overnight parking, tuck into the seat cushions when moving, always check to make sure back ropes are not near or entwined in prop, **do not remove from the boat**
- ☐ Lily Pad – all boats are equipped with a lily pad to be used as a wave bumper, feel free to use the lily pad when docked or coving out but always roll up and secure with a rope onto the front of the boat while in transit. Do not jump off boat or dock onto the lily pad, it will tear
- ☐ Boat – video taken and visual check for condition, point out any damage prior to leaving Pointe Oasis, damaged incurred during rental will be assessed and charged for when rental is complete, call Pointe Oasis immediately if damage incurs during rental including damage caused by a third party. You may be required to call water patrol and file a report.
- ☐ Doors – instructions on use, always close doors during transit
- ☐ Anchor – location in the boat, where to tie up and additional instructions on use and cleaning before storing. Always use anchor for coving out. NEVER “BEACH” or run boat ashore. This will cause motor damage.
- ☐ Life Jackets – 12 safety vests located under the seats in the boat, provide additional instructions on use. All life jackets (12 coast guard and/or borrowed jackets) will be counted and must be returned.
- ☐ Radio – instructions on use (switch, bluetooth, courtesy lights)
- ☐ Safety Equipment – location of the fire extinguisher, throwable seat cushion, ski flag, kill switch
- ☐ Cooler – for food and beverage use only, do not store fish in a Pointe Oasis cooler
- ☐ Boat Key – instructions on use, always wear when boat is in operation, store in the sink when coving out or parked
- ☐ Registration papers are in storage, water patrol and/or coast guard can pull you over and you will need to provide proper documentation for boat and operator (including MO Safety Certificate, if needed).
- ☐ If damage occurs during rental, contact Pointe Oasis immediately this includes damaged caused by a third party. You may be required to contact water patrol and file a report.
- ☐ **Designated Driver and NO Smoking Policy**
- ☐ Gauges – trim, gas, speedometer, depth finder
- ☐ Boat Operation – throttle sensitivity, engine noise, direction, trim
- ☐ No Wake and Danger buoys – stay at least 150 feet from shore and other boats/waverunners
- ☐ Docking – instructions at their own dock and including where and when to return the boat to Pointe Oasis
- ☐ How to take waves and how to back up, distribute weight evenly and put more weight in the back when in the main channel, **do not boat during inclement weather**
- ☐ Must return with a Clean Interior (\$50 charge for cleaning)
- ☐ Rental kit - trash bag, koozies, lake information, Pointe Oasis information including phone number
- ☐ Landmarks – 13mm of Wideford Cove, point out Cypress, Four Seasons, Palisades
- ☐ All items damaged and/or not returned including jackets, ropes, lily pad, tubes, coolers, etc will be assessed and charged at rental return

Instructor will stay with the boat until renter is clear of the dock & provide needed verbal instructions.
